Scholarship Program information & Guidelines

What is this Scholarship?

A fully funded undergraduate scholarship for talented students from financially deserving backgrounds, especially from remote and underserved areas of Pakistan.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Academic: Minimum 75% marks (FSc/FA or equivalent)
2. Financial Need: Must demonstrate genuine need through income, family size, assets, and documents.

How to Apply

1. Apply through the official online portal. www.case.edu.pk
2. Incomplete applications will be rejected.

Selection Process

1. Diagnostic Test
Students from remote or educationally disadvantaged backgrounds may undergo structured diagnostic screening before final evaluation.
 - Duration: 2 hours
 - Mode: Secure proctored test (physical or online)
 - Sections:
 - Basic Mathematics
 - Analytical Reasoning
 - English Proficiency
 - Subject Fundamentals
2. Bridge Program
Intensive Preparatory Classes
The Institute shall provide targeted reinforcement to address educational gaps prior to final testing.
Curriculum Includes:
 - Foundation Mathematics
 - Academic English
 - Logical Reasoning
 - Digital Literacy
 - Study Skills
 - Program-specific basics
 - Bi-weekly internal assessments
 - Completion certificate required for STET eligibility
3. Final Test (SSTET)
 - Based on FSc/ICS curriculum
 - With focus on reasoning over rote learning

- Having sections: Quantitative, Analytical, English, Subject Aptitude Eligible candidates shall appear in the SS CASE-IT Scrutiny & Talent Evaluation Test.

Component	Weight
Quantitative & Mathematical Reasoning	30%
Analytical & Logical Reasoning	25%
English Comprehension & Writing	20%
Subject-Specific Aptitude	25%

4. Interview
5. Final selection based on Academic performance (60%) + Financial Need (40%).
